Monique is a relatively new member of the Southland Regional Association of REALTORS® since January 2007; however in that window of time she is making her mark among her REALTOR® peers and in her community.

Monique is a life-long resident of the San Fernando Valley and she believes that professionals should participate and give back to the community in which they operate. Last May, she successfully closed escrow for an organization called RideOn. RideOn was established in 1994 as a non-profit organization that provides therapeutic horseback riding lessons for children and adults with mental and physical disabilities. For the past 14 years, RideOn leased its Chatsworth ranch, after much research Monique was able to secure a new "home" that RideOn is now the proud owner of. After escrow was closed, Monique made a donation to the organization, and is now a volunteer. Monique says "The lives of horses will be saved if they are selected to be trained to provide much needed therapy; the lives of riders will be improved immeasurably, and the land is being put to good use that is supported by the Chatsworth community".

This past November Monique raised enough money to purchase 1,000 dinner rolls and 250 pounds of canned vegetables for the San Fernando Valley Rescue Mission's annual Thanksgiving dinner for the homeless. Monique also raised money in December by placing an announcement in her newsletter soliciting donations for the Rescue Mission and other charities that are providing services to those displaced by the recent fires.
